- 1. Update on our financial situation and staffing changes**
 - a. Budget for this year was a big question mark since we lost Kendeda and Ciderfest**
 - b. We had filled those voids in the budget with other grants and private donors but so far those funds have not come in. We have a possible \$300,000 gap in expenses.**
 - c. Sam and EC have developed a contingency plan.**
 - d. Steffi had wrapped up most of her specific projects and we felt that it was time to let her go given our financial concerns. We have staff and contractor capacity to cover website and salesforce maintenance.**
 - e. Kalen is cutting back to 5 hours a week and she has another job at the forest service**
 - f. There could be other staffing cuts if we don't meet our fundraising goals at the annual party (30k).**
 - g. Fundraising event at Brad's house and associated campaign.**

 - k. DOE grant should hear back this month.**
 - l. Amber suggests reducing staff time to 75%. Sam took that off the list just because he hopes it doesn't get to that point.**

- This Wednesday September 13th is the Membership appreciation party at the Wedge Foundation! Please come and invite your friends.
- We have a signed contract for the next round of funding for BHP and ESN. There was a reduction in funds that we were able to partially offset through ARPA funding for ESN.
- The new GBA Website was launched July 7th.
- Green Built Homes: Number of GBH certified in August: 19
 - Homes Registered in August: 18
 - Platinum Net-Zero: 1
 - Net-Zero Ready: 2
 - Total number registered currently: 106
 - Total certified currently: 2908
- Membership: At the end of August we had 223 current members, which is down from last year. We processed 22 members in April, gained four new members. We have realized there is a discrepancy between the website and our tracking list, which we have been over reporting by 15-20 members per months for many months.
- Appalachian Offsets: The potential project for United Way is getting closer to the goal. We meet with UW on July 25th to talk through the next steps.
- The Beloved PV system is being installed this week.
- ESN Heating Repair and Replacement Program- Sustainable Air and Rutherford heating is installing and repairing heating systems for ESN clients. This is funded by County and City ARPA funds. We hope to do this again next year.
- We have eight contractors/consultants with GBA: Brad Rouse, David Gordon, Tony Beurskens, Amy Musser, Branson Bullman, Sugar Hollow Solar, Sustainable Air, and Rutherford Heating and Air.
